HOMEWORK HELP

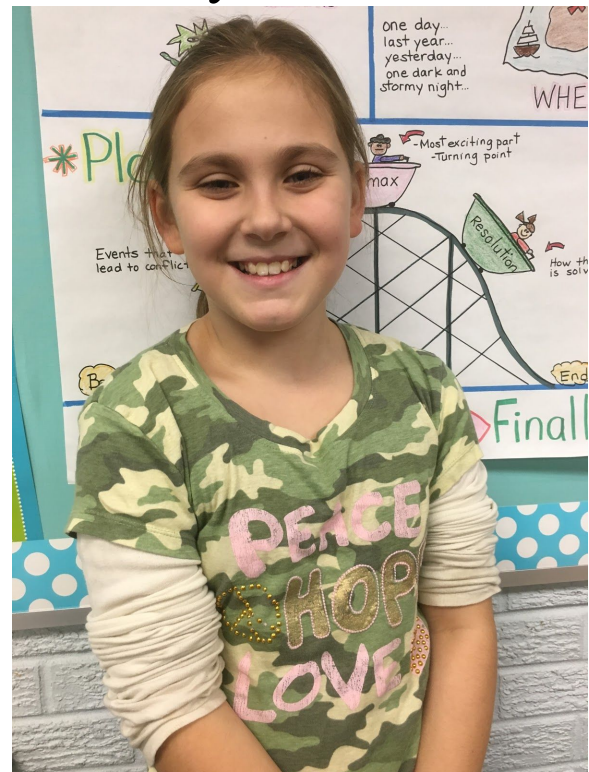
Parents have asked how to help
